SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FOR DEPENDENT CHILDREN OF TUSTIN EDUCATORS ASSOCIATION MEMBERS

Qualifications:

- A minimum grade point average of 3.0
- Applying to or currently enrolled at a technical/trade school, 2-year community college, or a 4-year college/university during the 2025-2026 school year
- A legal dependent of a current member of the Tustin Educators Association
- Completion of a formal application for scholarship consideration (application must be typed)
- Applicants can only apply once and successful applicants will only receive 1 scholarship.
- The number of recipients is limited to funds raised and quality of applications. Award amounts will be \$1000 for successful 4-year applicants and \$250 for successful Technical/Trade School or 2-year applicants.

Type, print, and submit a completed application to the Tustin Educators Association Scholarship Committee, located at 4940 Irvine Blvd, Suite 205, Irvine, CA 92620-7916, by **Friday, March 27, 2026, 4:00 PM.**

A complete application packet must include the following documents:

- A most recent school transcript (official or unofficial), with identity information (Full Name, DOB, etc)
- A current, signed letter of recommendation specific to this scholarship application from a teacher, counselor, or administrator at your present or most recent school who is not related to you
- A completed, typed application, including a typed essay response no more than 500 words

Official verification of your enrollment in a technical/trade school, 2-year community college, or a 4-year college/university shall be required prior to your receipt of the scholarship check.
